

Combining multiple columns into one in Excel

This is the easiest way to take the contents of multiple columns and combine them into a single column.

My example uses the ip address 192.168.0.1 where each octet and each . between each octet exists in a different column.

F	G	H	I	J	K	L
192	.	168	.	0	.	1

Choose a cell, and enter the following formula... It's just like doing a SUM to add numbers, only you use CONCATENATE instead.

fx =CONCATENATE(F1,G1,H1,I1,J1,K1,L1)								
D	E	F	G	H	I	J	K	L
	E(F1,G1,H1,I1,J1,K1,L1)	192	.	168	.	0	.	1

Hit enter and voila.

=CONCATENATE(F1,G1,H1,I1,J1,K1,L1)								
D	E	F	G	H	I	J	K	L
	192.168.0.1	192	.	168	.	0	.	1
